



You may have completed one or more of the four Phases of COPP and should be honored, recognized and receive your certificate and or diploma at a graduation ceremony. In 1978, Dr. Amos Jones, Jr., undertook the leadership of the COP Program to take it to new heights.

- 3. To provide an educational structure that will develop candidates qualified for teaching and leadership position;
- 4. To provide incentives for the candidates to complete the program; and
- 5. To produce trained church leaders.
